Residency Agreement

Come Rest Awhile (CRA) is a non-profit corporation which provides a drug and alcohol free environment providing individual and group support for women transitioning from treatment to a clean and sober life. This is a shared living space, and rules are required to make it a safe and supportive environment for all. By your signature below you agree to be strictly bound by all terms of this Residency Agreement which you acknowledge reading.

There may be immediate termination of residency for any rule violation, and you agree to leave immediately and without formal eviction procedures. All personal property must be removed within 24 hours or put in storage. Items not retrieved within 30 days will be disposed of.

HOUSE RULES

1. All premises are drug and alcohol free and the possession of alcohol, illegal drugs, non-prescribed controlled substances, or inhalants is prohibited. Residents and guests may not use, possess or share alcohol, illegal drugs, controlled substances, prescription drugs without a prescription, or inhalants either on or off the premises. **Any infraction of this rule will result in immediate termination of residency.** Residents of CRA agree that CRA may conduct random room and personal property searches and alcohol and/or drug testing is required at the request of CRA.
2. Residents are required to advise CRA of all prescribed medications. **Any changes in medication MUST be reported to CRA staff at time of change.** The storage and consumption of medication, other than pain medication, are the tenant's responsibility. Pain medication, prescribed in special circumstances such as surgery or injury, shall be turned over to CRA staff for distribution. **In cases of stealing, sharing, or trading medications, all parties involved will be immediately discharged and residency terminated.**
3. Residents will sign releases authorizing doctors, treatment providers, and contact persons to communicate freely with CRA. No resident shall make physical or verbal threats against other residents or staff, and any such behavior may result in immediate discharge and termination of residency.
4. No overnight guests are allowed without CRA permission.
5. The curfew is 10:30 PM from Sunday through Thursday, and 11:00 PM Friday and Saturday. All activities are to be quiet and doors locked by 11:00 PM.
6. Visitors, typically program sponsors or family members, are welcome between the hours of 10:00 AM and 9:00 PM. All residents are asked to be considerate of the privacy of others when having guests. No men are allowed in the residents' private space.
7. No overnight passes will be issued for 30 days. Thereafter, overnight passes must be requested 24 hours in advance and approved by staff.
8. Residents are responsible for their own hygiene and personal space. **All beds** must be made prior to leaving for the day.
9. All residents are required to be awake and dressed by 10:00 AM.
10. Housekeeping responsibilities will be assigned in community meeting and posted on the bulletin board.
11. Smoking is allowed **ONLY ON THE PATIO OUTSIDE THE TV ROOM**. This includes E cigarettes.
12. Residents must sign out and notify staff of their whereabouts and return time.
13. All residents at CRA are required to attend a minimum of three (3) 12 step meeting per week, get a program sponsor, and work a 12 step recovery program. Residents are also required to attend the house meeting weekly and Miracles Happen AA meeting on Tuesday evenings.
14. All monies paid to CRA for the final month of residence is nonrefundable, even if the resident is asked to leave.

I have read and agree to comply with and be strictly bound by the above rules for Come Rest Awhile at all times.
